

School Counselor PD & RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

EY POINTS



Michigan School Counselor Licenses (SCL) and teaching certificates with a School Counselor (NT) endorsement are five-year licenses with unlimited renewals.



A renewal can be requested any time after January 1 of the expiration year and adds five years to the license's validity.



Fifty of the 150 hours required for renewal must be specific to college and career preparation and be completed via State Continuing Education Clock Hours (SCECHs). Note: District Provided Professional Development (DPPD) does not fulfill the requirement.





Effective Feb. 6, 2020, any applications lacking the appropriate professional development hours (including focus and type) will not be accepted.
